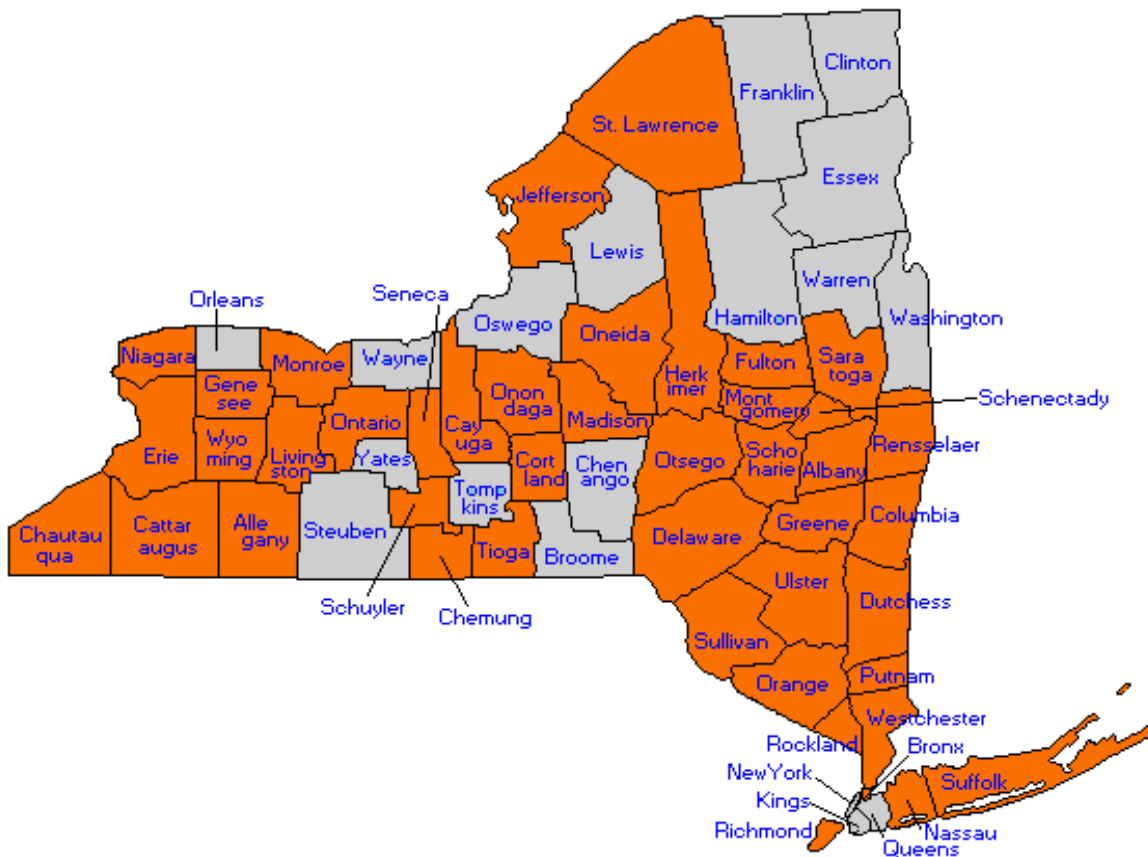

- 3 State Assemblymen

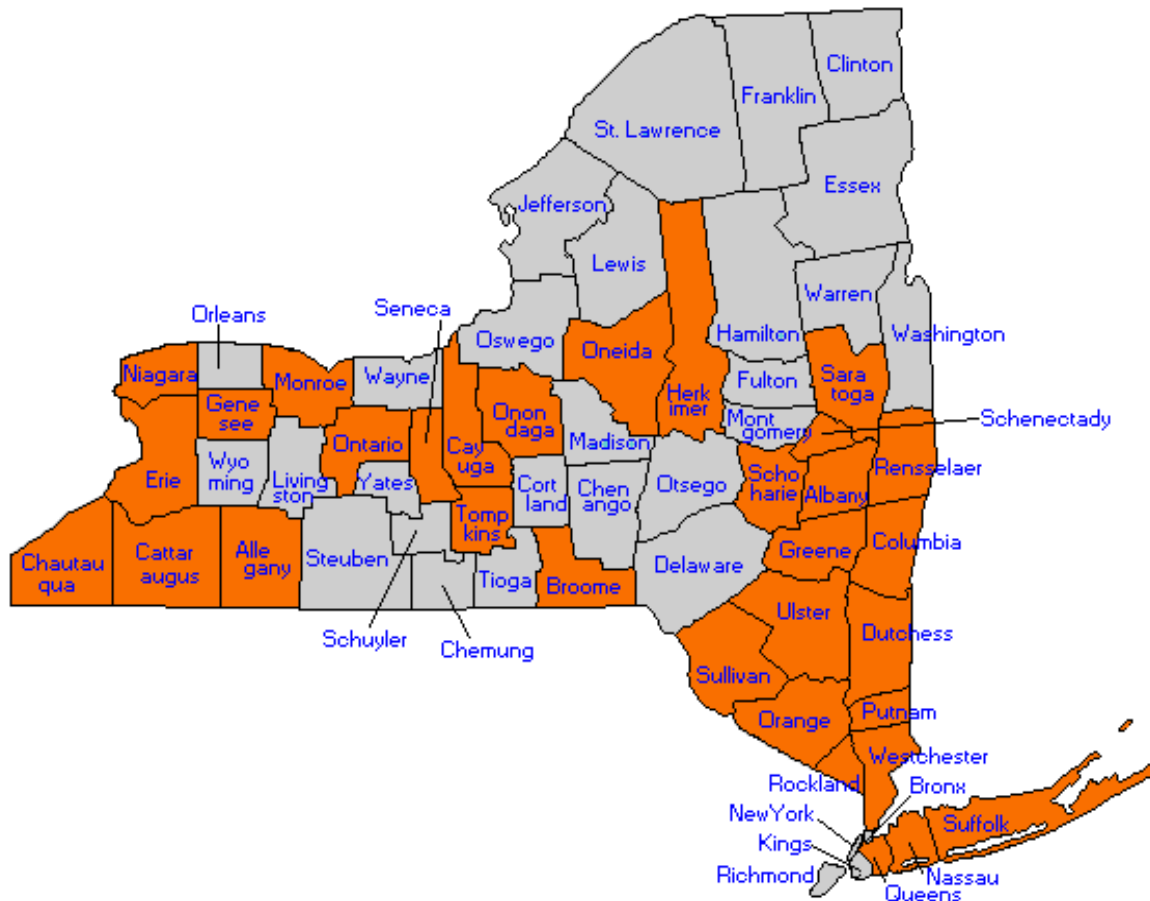
Anti-gun candidates defeated in general elections:
